Celebrate the 30th Anniversary of Star Wars

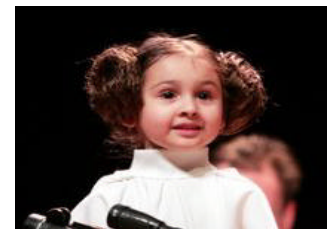

This special screening is followed by five-days of events celebrating the 30th Anniversary of the saga, which will be held at the Los Angeles Convention Center. Stars from the six film Saga will make special appearances during the Star Wars Celebration IV.

For generations of Star Wars fans this will be an exciting event filled with live entertainment, special film and video presentations, an exhibit of movie props and costumes, exclusive merchandise sold at a 24-hour-a-day store, pop culture tributes, costume contests, and scores of additional activities for all ages.

The Los Angeles Convention Center is located at: 1201 South Figueroa, Los Angeles, Calif. Admission to the first day of the event, Thursday, May 24, will be reserved for

worldwide members of the Official Star Wars Fan Club. The convention will be open to the general public from Friday, May 25, through Monday, May 28, 2007.



Advance purchase ticket prices for the event range from a 1-Day Adult pass for \$40 to a 4-Day Adult pass for \$110. A 1-Day Child pass is \$20 and a 4-Day Child pass is \$45. Onsite purchases cost \$125 for a 4-Day Adult pass, \$45 for a 1-Day Adult pass, and \$55 for a 4-Day Child pass and \$25 for a 1-Day Child pass. Children under 6 are admitted to Celebration IV free.
